

E-ZPass Plans and Application Tips

New Jersey E-ZPass Standard Plan (Amount \$25.00):

No minimum use is required. Some toll facilities offer all *E-ZPass* customers an automatic discount rate (no enrollment requirements). This rate varies depending on the roadway. This plan may be used wherever you see the *E-ZPass* sign displayed. A minimum of \$25.00 is required to open an account.

New Jersey E-ZPass Discount Plans: Go to the www.ezpassnj.com website and click on the “*E-ZPass* Information” icon and then click on “Plan Descriptions” to view the complete list of discount plans supported by the New Jersey *E-ZPass* Program along with the Plan’s specific requirements, documentation, and prepayment amounts required by those discount plans.

The Plans listed below can be applied for on this application provided you meet the Plan’s specific requirements, supply any additional documentation requested, and make the required prepayment.

ACE- Atlantic City Expressway Frequent User Plan: Tag specific discount plan that requires enrollment. Enrolled *E-ZPass* customers making a certain number of trips using their *E-ZPass* tag within a specified period of time will receive an additional discount under the Frequent User Plan for the next time period.

DRBACMTP - Delaware Memorial Bridge Commuter Plan: Tag specific plan that requires a minimum number of trips on the Delaware Memorial Bridge in a period of 30 days to receive a discount. Requires an additional \$25.00 in monthly replenishment.

DRBAFTP - Delaware Memorial Bridge Frequent Traveler Plan: Tag specific plan that requires a minimum number of trips within a specified number of days on the Delaware Memorial Bridge to receive the discount. Requires an additional \$25.00 in monthly replenishment.

DRJTBC - Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission Commuter Discount Plan: Tag Specific with no sign-up required provides a 40% discount on *E-ZPass* trips based on a tag on the account completing 16 trips in the calendar month. The discount is credited to your account each month for trips taken the previous month. The plan is tag specific and only applies to Class 1 vehicles.

DRPADP – Delaware River Port Authority Discount Plan: The DRPA Discount plan provides a credit of \$18.00 for an enrolled NJ *E-ZPass* Class 1 tag making 18 or more trips on any of the DRPA bridges in a calendar month.

DRPASR – Delaware River Port Authority Senior Citizen’s Plan: Customers must provide proof of eligible age (65 or over) and have the vehicles registered in PA, NJ or DE to enroll in the plan and receive a discount on Senior Discount Plan for the Benjamin Franklin, Walt Whitman, Betsy Ross and Commodore Barry bridges. Once your account is open please call either 856-968-2000 and press five or 215-218-3750 and press five to request the plan. GSPTRLR - Garden State Parkway Trailer Discount Plan: Tag specific plan that provides discounts to certain classes of vehicles pulling a trailer when traveling on the Garden State Parkway, as detailed on the website.

NJGREEN- Turnpike/Garden State Parkway Green Pass Discount Plan: Tag specific plan that offers discount to the full fare off peak toll. Vehicles that obtain at least 45 miles per gallon and meet the California Super Ultra Low Emission Vehicle (SULEV) standard are eligible for the discount. **Copy of vehicle registration is required to add this plan.**

NJSENIOR – Senior Citizens Discount Plan: Customers must provide proof of eligible age (65 and over) to enroll in the plan and receive a discount off the full fare off-peak toll on the New Jersey Turnpike and Garden State Parkway. NYSBA - NY State Bridge Authority Discount: Tag specific plan that requires a monthly minimum usage over any of the following bridges: Rip Van Winkle, Kingston Rhinecliff, Mid-Hudson, Newburgh-Beacon, and the Bear Mountain. Requires an additional \$25.00 in monthly replenishment.

PASI - Port Authority of NY & NJ Staten Island Bridges Plan: This plan requires an advance purchase of trips. The plan is account specific providing commuters with significant discounts on the Goethals and Bayonne Bridges, and the Outerbridge Crossing.

PACP - Port Authority of NY & NJ Carpool Plan: Account specific plan that requires a certain number of occupants in a passenger vehicle with noncommercial plates and requires the vehicle to use a staffed lane to verify occupancy.

Important Tips About the E-ZPass Application

ACCOUNT ACCESS INFORMATION

You MUST provide a 4 digit PIN # to access your account via the automated voice system OR give your application number (other identifying information) when speaking to a customer service representative.

TAG REQUEST (Section 4, Lines A)

Most vehicles can operate with interior tags. Customer Service Representative (CSR) will determine if exterior tag is needed. Enter the license plate and vehicle data under Section 3 Vehicle Information and the number of tags you need in Section 4, Line A.

PRE-PAYMENT CALCULATION (Section 4, Lines B-G)

Select the *E-ZPass* plan(s) that meet your needs. The dollar amount listed next to each discount plan offered under the New Jersey *E-ZPass* Discount Plan section is the minimum prepaid amount for that plan. Enter this amount in the “Minimum Prepaid Amount” column for all selected plans. The total dollar amount of all discount plans requested is entered on Line E.

- **TAG DEPOSIT (LINE B):** Check and cash customers will be charged a refundable Tag Deposit per tag as listed in the Terms and Conditions. The tag deposit is waived if you maintain a valid credit/debit or bank account on file with NJ *E-ZPass* that will be used to automatically replenish your Account.
- **BASIC PLAN (LINE C):** Customers are required to pay a minimum prepaid amount of \$25.00 for up to 6 tags using a credit card, debit from bank checking account, cash or check.
- **DISCOUNT PLANS (LINES D-E):** The dollar amount listed next to each discount plan offered under the New Jersey *E-ZPass* Discount Plans section is the minimum prepaid amount for that plan. Enter this amount in the “Minimum Prepaid Amount” column for all selected plans. The total dollar amount of all discount plans requested is entered on Line E.
- **ADDITIONAL PREPAID TOLL AMOUNT (LINE F):** If the total prepaid amount from the selected *E-ZPass* plan(s) will not cover your first month of anticipated charges, enter an additional amount on Line F.
- **INITIAL PAYMENT (LINE G):** Add Lines B, C, E and F and enter the total on Line G.

ACCOUNT REPLENISHMENT OPTION (Section 5)

- **AUTO CREDIT CARD REPLENISHMENT: The Easiest Way to Pay**
To automatically replenish by credit card, visit the *E-ZPass* website at www.ezpassnj.com, or in person at one of our Walk-In Centers. Provided for the convenience of the customer, a secondary credit card option is available in case the primary auto credit card does not process correctly. There are many advantages to automatically starting and replenishing your *E-ZPass* account with a credit card:
 - No tag deposit is required.
 - It’s easy. There’s no need to worry about a separate *E-ZPass* payment.
 - You are automatically enrolled in *E-ZPass* Plus.
 - *E-ZPass* Plus charges of \$20.00 and over are charged directly to your credit card.

- **AUTO DIRECT DEBIT FROM BANK CHECKING ACCOUNT**
To automatically replenish by direct debit from a bank checking account, place a checkmark in Option 1. Enclose a voided check from your bank checking account. You must enclose a check or money order for the amount computed in the Total Initial Payment of the application.
 - No tag deposit is required.
 - It’s easy. There’s no need to worry about a separate *E-ZPass* payment.

- **ONE TIME REPLENISHMENTS**
One time replenishment using cash must be made in person at any of the New Jersey *E-ZPass* Walk-In Center locations listed on the insert. Check payments can be made in person or by mail. One time replenishment using credit/debit card can be made online at www.ezpassnj.com or in person at any of the New Jersey *E-ZPass* Walk-In Center locations.

If any required information or documentation is missing from your application, the application will be rejected and returned to you.

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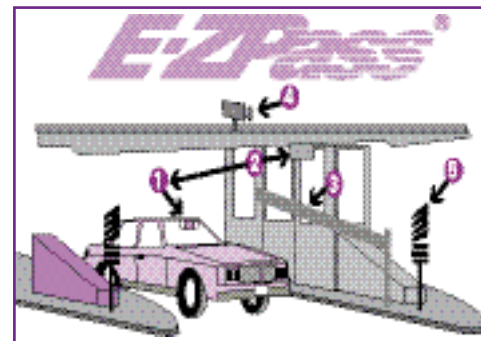

- 1 As you pass through the *E-ZPass* facility, your *E-ZPass tag* is read.
- 2 In an instant, the tag information is read by an *overhead antenna* in the *E-ZPass* facility and the proper charge is deducted from your *E-ZPass* account.
- 3 At some facilities, there are *gates* that will go up when a valid tag is read.
- 4 A *video enforcement system* is in place to identify charge evaders.
- 5 A *traffic signal and message* is immediately displayed to you just beyond the *E-ZPass* facility, with the exception of express *E-ZPass* lanes.

Certain Vehicles Require an Exterior Tag

Certain vehicles are equipped with special windshields that may contain metal in the glass that prevents the *E-ZPass* tag from being read properly. Customers with these windshields will be issued an exterior tag. Your NJ *E-ZPass* customer service representative will mail you the appropriate tag based on the make and model you indicate on the application.
